Important Propane Safety Information

Pursuant to New Jersey state law (N.J.A.C 5:18) and NFPA 54 code standards, all propane tanks that experience any disruption of service (fuel run-outs, leaks, damage to equipment, etc.) will be 'locked off' until a gas safety leak test is performed by a certified



Stem Brothers service technician. Once the system is deemed to be safe and free from any leaks; the service technician will place the system back in operation and relight any appliances. This will be a billable service charge, unless the tank was set up in our computer system on automatic delivery.

Here are some ways to avoid an empty propane tank and service call:

- Change your delivery status to automatic delivery.
- Call for a delivery well in advance of our 48 hour delivery window.
- Pay close attention to the tank gauge level when utilizing propane for auxiliary usage i.e., generators, gas log sets, pool heaters, etc. (Automatic delivery customers must contact our office to update our computer system with any extended usages with the aforementioned.)
